Behaviour Management Policy

At Saddleworth our vision is to provide students with a **secure** environment with **quality relationships**, a **diversity** of learning and programmes, to celebrate **achievement** and to provide an **enjoyable** learning environment.

Our school values are embedded as part of our daily practise. Class rules are developed in each class in consultation with peers and teachers at the start of each school year. These rules are displayed in the classroom and are referred to regularly.

Our Pastoral Care Worker (PCW) also works with classes on a weekly basis on a social skills programme where activities and lessons reflect our school values and class rules.

The consequences of not following our schools rules:

The following offences will be entered on EDSAS, skip the 3 step process above with the Principal or Acting Principal to manage:

Verbal Assault (including swearing)

Physical Assault

Bullying - Severe

Leaving School Grounds

Threatening Safety or Wellbeing

(These may result in Suspension, Exclusion or Expulsion as per DECD protocol).

Bullying Record Folder

Any cases of bullying will be recorded in the 'Bullying Record Folder' where the date, time, type of offence, people involved and follow-up procedures documented.

*3 yellow slips per term will result in an internal suspension where DECD SEE (Suspension, Exclusion, Expulsion) Procedures occur and are facilitated by the Principal with student and parent involvement.

There will be a fun event at the end of each term for students except ones who have received 3 or more yellow slips or who have been suspended.
